The heart of Warsaw, the must-essential Warsaw, the history of Warsaw as a capital of Poland is found in any single cobblestone or a brick of city walls.

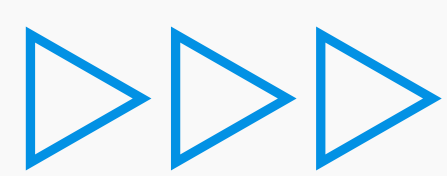
Walk around the most important architecture of the Old and New Towns:

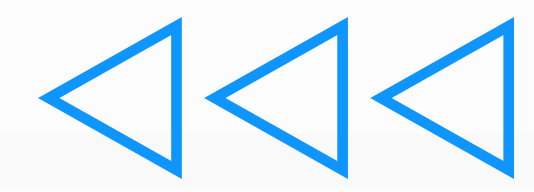

In-person or virtual presenters will have 13 minutes for paper presentation, and then 2 minutes for Q&A.

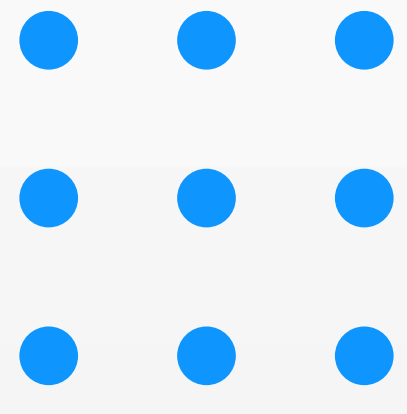
